## Contrasts between Mount Sinai and Mount Zion.

## from Hebrews 12-D

- 1- Mount Sinai was marked by <u>fear</u> and <u>terror</u>. Mount Zion is a place of <u>love</u> and <u>forgiveness</u>.
- 2- Mount Sinai is in the wilderness. Mount Zion is the city of the Living God. (Hebrew adjectives: "beautiful; habitable; magnificent")
- 3- Mount Sinai spoke of <u>earthly</u> things. Mount Zion speaks of <u>heavenly</u> things.
- 4 At Mount Sinai, only Moses was allowed to draw near to God. At Mount Zion, an innumerable company, a general assembly is invited to draw near.
- 5 Mount Sinai was all about <u>keeping people away</u> from the mountain & God's holiness. Mount Zion is all about <u>invitation to</u> draw near to Him.
- 6 At Mount Sinai, <u>Moses</u> was the mediator. At Mount Zion, <u>Jesus</u> is the mediator.
- 7- Mount Sinai brings an Old Covenant, which was ratified by the blood of animals. Mount Zion brings a New Covenant, which is ratified by the blood of God's precious Son.
- 8-Mount Sinai was characterized by <u>guilty</u> people in fear. Mount Zion features righteous people made perfect by God.

GR= telioo "made complete; perfect"

9- Mount Sinai is all about Law. Mount Zion is all about grace.
