ROMANS 15:4

- 1.) Just because circumstances don't <u>look</u> like a plan, it doesn't mean that God doesn't have one.

 *remember Romans 8:28 "...<u>all</u> things are working together for the good of those who love God & are called according to His purpose."
- 2.) God doesn't always explain the plan to us--even when we're in it.*Joseph didn't have a clue until the end of the story.
- 3.) When bad things happen, God is still in control. *every step of the way, Joseph ended up exactly where God needed him to be.
- 4.) It is possible to be exactly where God wants you to be, even when you are there because of other peoples' choices—-(even when those choices were made for the wrong reasons!)

 *Joseph had no say in any of the things that affected his life, yet despite out-of-control people governing him, he was right in God's plan the whole time.

 *remember at the end he said: "you intended it for evil, but God meant it for good."
- 5.) Sometimes God blesses (or teaches) other people at our expense.

 *that is because sometimes the plan is bigger than just our own lives & comfort.
- 6.) Sometimes the BEST answer to our prayers is "no" or "not now", even when we are uncomfortable or trapped.
 *If God had let Joseph out of prison when Joseph wanted it, two nations would've starved to death!
- 7.) God will be with us NO MATTER WHAT!
 *It's true that God could've delivered Joseph at any time, but He never left him alone.
- 8.) Doing the right things doesn't always guarantee a smooth life.
 *Even when the ultimate result of the plan is good. (read Psalm 37 and Psalm 73)
- 9.) GOD IS NOT IN A HURRY (and we are)

 *Joseph waited 20 years to do one thing

 (read Proverbs 3:5....it implies that God is going to do

 things that we won't understand.)
- 10.) The end of His plan is ALWAYS worth the trouble and the wait.
- 11.) God is able to bless us in such a way as to cause us to forget the pain.

 *Joseph named his first son "Menasseh" which moans

*Joseph named his first son "Menasseh", which means 'forget', he said: "because God has caused me to forget my suffering in the land of my affliction."

12.) One day can change EVERYTHING.

*And the day before that day, it looks like nothing will ever change!

----Don't ever judge the future based on what you can see now.
